



Class Schedule

Class name: Arezzo - Intermediate Crochet

Description: Arezzo is a lacy, drapery neck kerchief approximately 41 in. in length and 14 in. at the deepest point. Crocheted with Lana Grossa Lace Lux, it has a lovely sheen, as well. Arezzo is crocheted from the longest side, decreasing every other row down to the point. The edging is a combination of progressively taller stitches and picots.

Experience required: Must be able to chain, single crochet, double crochet, and count stitches. Some ability to read patterns is helpful. This project is considered an intermediate-level project.

Materials required: 1 ball of Lana Grossa Lace Lux, Arezzo pattern provided by Haus of Yarn, and crochet hook size "7" (4.5mm). A "7" hook is between a "G" hook and an "H" hook. You can use a "G" to make the kerchief. You can also use an "E" or an "F" hook; however, the kerchief will not be quite as drapery. Darning needle for weaving in ends.

Class name: Baby Surprise Jacket

Description: Join us for this fun and weird little knit from Elizabeth Zimmermann. This classic hand-knit sweater is fun and unusual in its construction - it will look like no sweater you've ever knit - until you get to the very end.

Experience required: Must be able to cast-on, knit and purl.

Techniques learned: Increase, decrease, picking up stitches, seaming.

Materials required: Baby Surprise Jacket pattern Yarn: 6 sts per inch for infant size, go up to 4.25 sts per inch for a comfortable toddler size. Needles appropriate for yarn Stitch markers Darning needle

Description: Learn basic stitches of single and double crochet as we make a dishcloth.

Experience required: No prior crochet experience necessary.

Experience required: Absolute beginner; no prior knitting experience needed

Techniques learned: Learn the necessary basics: Cast on, knit, purl, bind off, yarn over, I-cord and seaming as you make a hat.

Materials required: About 200 yards yarn, appropriate needles, and pattern

Class name: Block a Month Afghan Knit-A-Long

Description: Create your own afghan, one square at a time. Join us for a one hour guided session on the first Monday of the month and receive the block pattern. Please note that the first session may run longer than one hour to help with yarn selection. No need to sign up for this class, you can just show up!

Experience required: Beginners welcome. You need to know how to cast on, knit and purl, bind off.

Techniques learned: It's a surprise! Each month will be a different learning experience.

Materials required: Worsted weight yarn, 4.5 to 5 stitches per inch, about 150-200 yards per block.

Description: Need a quick last minute gift or want to make a nice luxury accessory for yourself? Look no further. Using a small amount of cashmere or some other yummy next-to-skin-soft yarn, you will learn to make a necklace or bracelet.

Experience required: Cast-on and off, knit, purl

Techniques learned: knit, purl, increase (yarn over) and decrease (knit 2 stitches together)

Materials required: 75 yards of fingering or sport weight yarn (cashmere or alpaca are recommended) Size 4 needles matching button Free pattern from Ravelry.com: [Cable Braided Necklace](#)

Class name: Calorimetry

Description: Learn how to short row while making this is a fun headscarf that acts as a hat without messing up your hair. Keep your ears warm while your pony tail hangs free.

Experience required: Basic knitting (cast on, knit, purl).

Materials required: 1 ball of Kureyon or Silk Garden or any worsted weight yarn, one size 7 or 8 circular needle, and two stitch markers.

Class name: Continental Knitting Workshop

Description: Increase your knitting speed using this traditional method in which the knitter uses their left hand to carry the working yarn.

Class name: Crochet Embellishment

Description: Has your knitting ever needed *something* but you aren't sure what? Maybe it needs crochet! Join us for this two part class and learn how to add crochet borders and other embellishments to your finished knitting projects.

Experience required: Basic Crochet Skills

Materials required: Yarn and hook, two 5" x 5" knitted swatches

Class name: Fake Isle

Description: Using a free pattern from spunkyeclectic.com, you will learn how to make your first Fair Isle project – a very simple hat made using one ball of Noro Kureyon and a plain, black yarn using to contrast and highlight the colors. The self-stripping yarn makes the project look far more complicated than it actually is. Learn how to carry yarns properly to make Fair Isle part of your knitting repertoire.

Experience required: Basic knitting (cast on, knit, purl).

Materials required: 1 skein Noro Kureyon 1 skein worsted black wool Choose one Two sz 6 24" circulars (if they are loose knitters) One sz 6 24" circ and two sz 8 24" circs (normal knitters). One size 6 24" circ and one set of DPNs (this means they will knit part of their hat on DPNs tapestry needle stitch markers

Class name: Featherweight Cardigan

Description: It seems everyone wants to make this simple and super stylish, lightweight cardigan - just 2-3 balls of Malabrigo Lace (only \$10 each!) are all you need to make this one. Or go super luxurious with 3-4 balls of Filatura di Crosa Superior cashmere and silk yarn. It is constructed from the top down, which makes it a breeze to knit. If you haven't yet made your first sweater, this is the class for you.

Experience required: Cast on, knit, purl

Materials required: (2-3) Malabrigo Lace*, pattern from Knitbot, Addi Lace needles (in two sizes), stitch markers, darning needle

Homework: Complete a 4x4 swatch using suggested yarn and needles

Class name: French Press Slippers

Description: Constructed more like a shoe than a sock, these felted slippers will keep you stylish AND comfortable! Also great for gifts, as it is a very quick project!

Experience required: Cast on, knit, purl, increase, decrease.

Materials required: French Press Pattern, worsted wool for felting like Ella Rae Classic Heathers or Plymouth Galway (2)*, size US 15 needle, two buttons, tapestry needle

Class name: Lessons for Children

Description: We will work with your child to learn the basics of knitting and crochet.

Experience required: No experience necessary, but children must be able to tie shoes. Recommended for ages 8 and older.

Materials required: Sock yarn, 40-47" circular needle, Magic Loop leaflet, darning needle.

Description: Learn the Magic Loop technique while making a top-down hat.

Experience required: Basic knitting skills

Techniques learned: Knitting in the round using Magic Loop.

Materials required: 2 ball Raggi or other worsted weight yarn 40" size 5 needle Stitch marker

Class name: MMM (Men's Malabrigo Mitts)

Description: Learn to make the man in your life a pair of mitts to keep his hands warm using just two sets of needles and one hank of Malabrigo worsted yarn.

Experience required: Must be comfortable with knitting and purl stitches.

Techniques learned: Knit in the round, purl, use 2 circular needles, gussets, increases.

Materials required: 1 Malabrigo Worsted (or 100 yards of comparable weight yarn) Free pattern from Ravelry.com: [75 Yard Malabrigo Fingerless Mitts](#) two #7 24" circular needles (Size 5 or 6 if you want to make a women's pair) two yarn markers tapestry needle

Class name: My First LACE Hat!

Description: Knit a stylish and quick lace beret while ramping up your knitting skills. Learn to read lace charts and work basic eyelet lace stitches in the round. This would be a great gift for a special woman (sized tween to adult) in your life.

Experience required: Must be able to knit in the round.

Techniques learned: Increases and decreases as used in lace and basic chart reading.

Materials required: 158 yards of aran weight solid colored yarn, one set of size 9 double pointed needles (or needles to meet gauge), stitch marker, tapestry needle, pattern: Trellis Beret by Woolly Wormhead.

Homework: Work brim as instructed in pattern. Do not do increase row.

Class name: Needle-Felted Embellishment

Description: Do you have a hat or sweater that needs a little something extra? Try adding a needle felted embellishment! This class will teach you the basics of applying a needle felted design on wool fabric--try a hat, scarf or even felted slippers. It's fun and no experience is required. (Needles are extremely sharp so this class is not suitable for children.)

Materials required: Needle felting tool and mat, wool roving and yarn for felting, surface for applying the embellishment (preferably 100% wool surface.) Roving sampler packs and embellishment blanks will be available for purchase.

Class name: Oops!

Description: Learn to read your knitting and fix basic mistakes. Problems that will be covered are fixing dropped, twisted or slipped stitches, tinkering, and lifelines.

Experience required: Knit, purl, bind off

Materials required: Practice yarn and appropriate needles

Homework required: Complete 3 swatches: one 5" x 5" garter stitch swatch, one 5" x 5" stockinette swatch, and one 5" x 5" seed stitch swatch, small amount of waste yarn in a different color than swatches, darning needle, stitch markers with an opening (either the "safety pin" type, or the circle with an open point). Leave swatches on needles – don't bind off! Make a 6" square if you want to turn your swatch into a bunny!

Class name: Pick your project

Description: Ready to knit your first sweater? Or challenge yourself with a technique you haven't attempted before? This is the class for you!

Experience required: Basic knitting (cast on, knit, purl).

Techniques learned: Selecting appropriate materials, swatching, gauge, pattern reading, and finishing

Materials required: Pattern, needles, and yarn of your choice

Suggested projects: Blue Sky Knit chicken, Wonderful Wallaby, Baby J Cardigan

Class name: Seams So Easy!

Description: If you shudder when you think about seaming up that lovely sweater you bound off just last night this class is for you! In this class we'll focus only on how to sew tidy and invisible shoulder and side seams. What used to seem so hard will "seam so easy" after taking this class.

Experience required: Basic knitting experience (knit and purl).

Materials required: Homework swatches, tapestry needle, several yards contrasting yarn to be used for seaming.

Homework required: Three squares at least 6" x 6" knit in plain stockinette stitch worked in worsted weight yarn, gauge 4-5 sts/inch. Light blocking is optional. Yarn should be smooth wool or wool blend, light, solid color. Encore, Ella Rae or Galway. No cotton. If you have a project that needs seaming, bring it to class and we'll get you started!

Class name: Socks on 2 Circulars - Beginner Socks

Description: This is the great take-it-with-you project! Learn how to make your first pair of socks without using double-pointed needles.

Experience required: Cast-on, knit and purl

Materials required: Leah Oakley Rib Play pattern, 2 size 5 24" circular needles, Raggi or Boomerang*

Class note: The second class is 3 hours long, from 3-6pm.

Techniques learned: Cable Cast-On Short Rows

Materials required: 765 yards of fingering or sport weight yarn like Noro Silk Garden Sock or Kauni Effekt. Bermuda pattern from Ilga Leja 32" circular US 7 needle Stitch markers Tapestry needle Blocking Pins

Class name: The Perfect Gift (Learn to Shape)

Description: Want to give a gift that money can't buy? Want to learn to increase/decrease and why? If so, this class is for you. In just three short hours, you can have a handcrafted wash cloth and be armed with the Ins and Outs of how to increase and decrease and why you choose the particular method to do them. We will also talk about small gift ideas and how you can give the gift that money can't buy !

Experience required: Basic knitting skills - cast-on, knit and purl.

Techniques learned: Increasing and decreasing

Materials required: worsted weight cotton and size 8 needle (straight or circular) OR DK weight cotton and size 6 or 7 needle 2 stitch markers

Class name: Thrummed Slippers

Description: Make a pair of fluffy and cozy slippers with thrums! Adding thrums (a small puff of wool fiber) is a great way to make an item super-duper warm. This class will teach you to make the thrums and get started on the technique of knitting them into the slippers.

Experience required: Must know how to cast-on and cast-off, knit and seam.

Techniques learned: Making and inserting thrums into your knitting.

Materials required: Retro Thrum Slipper pattern from Imperial Stock Ranch Columbia Yarn from Imperial Stock Ranch Roving from Imperial Stock Ranch

Class name: Top Down Summer Cardigan

Description: Here's a great spring wardrobe addition - the top down cardigan! Patterns knit from the top down require little to no seaming, making them a great first sweater project.

Experience required: Cast on, knit, purl

Materials required: Pattern, appropriate yarn* and needles, stitch markers, darning needle

Homework: Complete a 4" x 4" swatch

Class name: Two-At-A-Time Socks with One Circular Needle

Description: Beat that "2nd Sock Syndrome", knit them both at the same time! No more trying to figure out what you did with the first sock or fiddling with multiple needles. Using one long circular needle to knit both socks simultaneously will have you wondering why you ever did it any other way. We will be using a great pattern book with tons of references that you will use again and again. You will also learn some great tips on how to avoid the holes that show up on either side of the gusset and to create a fitted instep on any sock pattern for a supportive fit. Please note: Duration of second class is 3 hours, from 2:00pm - 5:00pm, to allow for turning the heel.

Experience required: Cast on, knit, purl, basic sock knitting/construction

Techniques learned: Learn how to knit two socks at a time with one circular needle.

Materials required: 2 skeins or approx. 400 yds worsted weight yarn , Raggi or Supersocke 2-at-a Time Socks by Melissa Morgan-Oakes 40 or 47 in. circular needle in size 3,4 or 5 depending on gauge locking stitch markers, darning needle

Homework: Gauge swatch needs to be completed before class. You will use either "Ragg Hiker" or "Pitter Patter" pattern, found in 2-at-a-Time Socks. Gauge for "Ragg Hiker" is 6 sts per inch. Gauge for "Pitter Patter" is 5.5 sts per inch.

Class name: Two-Color Brioché Scarf

Description: Give your wardrobe a little pizzaz and keep warm too! Add another technique to your knitting repertoire with this lovely reversible scarf. Brioché stitch (sometimes called shaker stitch, fisherman's rib or patent stitch) is a wonderful technique that creates an elastic, vertical ribbed fabric without using up too much yarn. Finished scarf will be approximately 3" wide and 5" long. Use two skeins of each color for wider and/or longer scarf.

Experience required: Beginners to advanced knitters will enjoy learning this technique. Must know how to knit and purl.

Materials required: 100yd/50gr each of 2 different colors of worsted weight yarn. Colors should contrast but complement each other. Size 7 or 8 double points. (Select a size up from recommended needle size.) Straight needles will not work for this pattern.

Description: Learn the basics of weaving on a rigid heddle loom. We will teach you to warp the loom and how to make a simple scarf. Bring your own loom or use ours.

Materials required: Loom 200-230 yards worsted or dk yarn

Class name: Weaving on a Loom - Advanced Techniques

Description: Expand the possibilities in your current weaving projects. Learn a few tricks to add texture, lace and even color on your rigid heddle loom.

Experience required: Must have beginning weaving.

Homework: Please bring your loom with a projects warped and ready to begin.

Class name: Wonderful Wallaby

Description: Get a headstart on winter, make a wonderful "Wonderful Wallaby"! This unique sweater can be made for the whole family, with sizing for 2 years old to an adult 48" chest. Super fun to knit, this isn't the best "first sweater" project, but perfectly suitable for a beginner knitter.

Experience required: Casting on, binding off, knitting and purling.

Techniques learned: Knitting in the round with circular needles and double pointed needles, picking up stitches, increasing, decreasing, and Kitchener stitch.

Materials required: Enough yarn for size (see pattern) - 4.5 stitches to the inch 24" circular needles, double points and straight needles to obtain this gauge. Stitch holders, ring stitch markers, locking stitch markers, tapestry needle, and crochet hook. The Wonderful Wallaby pattern booklet.
